# **TECHNICAL BULLETIN**

Oil Cooler Pipe Interference With Cross Brace – Service Action S717 MODEL 2004 MY XJ range

VIN

G00442-G22995

#### Issue:

A concern has been identified with the oil cooler return pipe on 2004 XJR vehicles within the above VIN range. The original design of the oil cooler pipe does not give adequate clearance to the cross brace. This can allow the oil cooler return pipe to interfere with the cross brace and, in some cases, contact the front securing bolt of the air deflector . This can cause the oil cooler return pipe to leak, resulting in engine oil on the underside of the vehicle and possible damage to the engine.

#### Action:

At the next service opportunity, change the oil cooler return pipe and replace the air reflector front retaining bolts with revised shorter bolts.

## WORKSHOP PROCEDURE


- 1. Open door and hood and install fender protection covers.
- 2. Open luggage compartment and install fender protection covers.
- 3. Disconnect the battery. See Workshop Procedure, JTIS CD ROM, section: 414-01, General Procedures.

**Note:** Ensure the radio security code is available before disconnecting the battery.

 Remove the cooling fan motor and shroud. See Workshop Procedure, JTIS CD ROM, section: 303-03A, SRO 26.25.25.



- 5. Remove the bolt securing the oil cooler return pipe to the cooler (Illustration 1).
- 6. Place a suitable oil drain tray under the vehicle.
- 7. Displace the oil cooler return pipe from the oil cooler.
- 8. Install suitable blanking plugs to the oil cooler and pipe.
- 9. Remove the bolt securing the oil cooler return pipe to the filter housing (Illustration 2).

- 10. Disconnect the oil cooler return pipe from the filter housing.
- 11. Install suitable blanking plugs to the oil cooler pipe and filter housing.
- 12. Remove the oil cooler return pipe from the vehicle and discard.
- 13. Align the new oil cooler return pipe to vehicle.
- 14. Remove the blanking plugs from the oil cooler return pipe and filter housing.
- 15. Fully install oil cooler return pipe to filter housing.
- 16. Install and fully tighten the bolt securing the oil cooler return pipe to the filter housing. Tighten to 7.6 10.4 Nm.



- 17. Remove the blanking plugs from the oil cooler return pipe and oil cooler.
- 18. Connect the oil cooler return pipe to the oil cooler.
- 19. Tighten the bolt securing the oil cooler return pipe to the oil cooler. Tighten to 6.8 9.2 Nm.
- 20. Clean any residual oil from the filter housing oil cooler pipe and cooler.
- 21. Remove the oil drain tray from under the vehicle.
- 22. Install the cooling fan motor and shroud. See Workshop Procedure, JTIS CD ROM, section: 303-03A, SRO 26.25.25.

**Note:** When re-installing the undertray air deflector, the front three bolts must be replaced with the parts listed in the Parts Information section of this Service Action.

- 23. Check and top up engine oil, if necessary.
- 24. Reconnect the battery. See Workshop Procedure, JTIS CD ROM, section: 414-01, General Procedures.
- 25. Remove rear fender protection covers and close the luggage compartment.
- 26. Remove front fender protection covers and close the hood and door.
