Floor Console Trim Separating – Not Adhering – Repair

MODEL 2004 MY XJ range VIN G00001-G19428

issue:

Some customers may have concerns with the floor console trim separating. This is not a split in the material but is caused by the material not being correctly adhered to the floor console.

Action:

In case of a customer complaint of console trim separating on a 2004 XJ, within the above VIN range, the floor console trim should be re-adhered to the floor console panel following the procedure below.

Note: This is the recommended repair and the floor console must not be replaced for this issue.

Note: Please also refer to Technical Bulletin XJ501-03 for additional areas of concern.

WORKSHOP PROCEDURE

- 1. Disconnect the battery (see Workshop Manual, JTIS CD ROM, section: 414-01, General Procedures).
- Remove floor console (see Workshop Manual, JTIS CD ROM, section: 501-12, SRO 76.25.01).
- If required, displace and remove the console glovebox.



- 4. Carefully turn back the trim at the affected areas as required (Illustration 1 shows likely areas of concern).
- 5. Apply suitable adhesive to exposed console and trim rear faces as required.

Note: 3M Fast Tack Trim Adhesive, P/N 080831, Bostik 4018 and Dunlop 1358 are the recommended adhesives, if they are not available then use a suitable locally sourced adhesive.

- 6. Allow adhesive to dry completely.
- 7. Apply another coat of adhesive to exposed console and trim rear faces.

Note: Always follow the instruction supplied with the adhesive.

- 8. Apply tension to trim and adhere to console by pressing down thoroughly.
- 9. If required, install the console glovebox.
- 10. Install floor console (see Workshop Manual, JTIS CD ROM, section: 501-12, SRO 76.25.01).
- 11. Connect the battery (see Workshop Manual, JTIS CD ROM, section: 414-01, General Procedures).

Note: 3M Fast Tack Trim Adhesive, Bostik 4018 and Dunlop 1358 (or a suitable locally sourced adhesive) are considered a workshop consumable and as such may not be claimed.
