TECHNICAL BULLETIN

Exterior Door Handle Stiff/Binding – Latch/Door Handle Mechanism – Lubricate Mechanism MODEL 2004 MY-ON XJ range VIN G00001-ON

Issue:

Some 2004 MY-ON XJ range vehicles may exhibit an exterior door handle that is stiff, binds or squeaks when opening the door.

This concern can be rectified by applying specified lubricant from the Squeaks and Rattles Repair Kit.

Action:

In case of a customer concern, apply lubricant to the door latch and door handle mechanism as outlined below.

Note: Use the grease (Carbaflo KSP205) and oil (Carbaflo KSP105) from the Squeaks and Rattles Repair Kit (JLM 21204). For replacement of oil and grease for the Squeaks and Rattles Repair Kit order JLM 21206.

- 1. Open the affected door(s).
- 2. Clean latch mechanism and apply a small amount of grease (KSP205) to the latch rotor (arrowed in Illustration 1).



3. Hold the exterior door handle open and rotate the latch rotor to the closed position, release the handle and rotate the latch rotor to ensure the grease contacts the latch pawl (Illustration 2).



- 4. Pull the exterior/interior door handle to open the latch.
- 5. Fully open the exterior door handle, clean handle and black plastic surfaces and apply a small amount of oil (KSP105) to all surfaces (arrowed in illustration 3).



- 6. Close and open the door to check operation.
- 7. Remove excess grease from the striker.
- 8. Carry out steps 2 to 7 for the remaining doors.
